Ecoprof Algol is a seaweedextract produced from the green seaweed Ascophyllum nodosum, and does not contain any chemical substances. **Ecoprof Algol** is very rich in organic connections, growth stimulators, trace elements and is allowed in organic farming cultures. This product can be applied directly at the roots of the plant. But because trace elements are considered most fit for delivery by foliar feeding, this product can also be applied directly to their leaves. The application of **Ecoprof Algol** can be repeated every 2-3 weeks, and needs to be stopped when flower buds or fruit buds are being produced.
